LOCAL: *San Rafael:* Riley Art Supply and Aaron Bros; *San Anselmo:* Perry's; *Terra Linda:* Michael's or Ben Franklin, *Mill Valley:* Art & Paper, Michael's Arts & Crafts.

ON-LINE: Dick Blick Art, Art Supply Warehouse, CheapJoe's, Utrecht.

Bring the items listed ..then add anything that you might want to try -see Options below.

1. paint -

- acrylic paint – your favorite colors plus white and black.
- *Optional:* pastels (hard or soft), crayons, markers, colored pencils,.....other (no oil paints please)

2. brushes -

- brushes: several – different styles, big and small. (I'll bring some to share)
- *Optional:* sponges, tissue paper, scraper, small paint rollers, house/hardware paint brushes...

3. **TWO** stretched canvas or canvas boards** for Exercises

- one 16x20 primed
- one 11x14 primed

****Canvas Panel by Art Alternatives or Fredrix are two brands. – there are many. You can buy on Amazon in packs of 3 - inexpensive. Or try local stores -often they have sales and you save shipping etc.**



4. **ONE 18x24** board or stretched canvas for main painting

- 18x24 or larger please
- Or....if you prefer..two medium size, e.g. two 16x20



5. palette tray or palette paper to mix paints
I use a 'butcher tray' like this (most art stores).

6. rags and/or paper towels

7. Container for rinse water e.g. large yogurt container

8. Spray water bottle for misting paints

9. Something to transport your wet/damp paintings in. Empty flat boxes work well. Acrylic dries quickly but if you have thick paint on the canvas it may still be wet.
